### LIBRARY SEARCH

Discover resources from your library collections and elsewhere using Library Search. Find books, articles, multimedia and much more.

*Tip: Sign in and use built in tools to help you save and share resources you find.*



### SUBJECT GUIDES

Explore key resources for subjects relating to your research as well as research tips and how to access help.

*Tip: Don't be limited to the subject guides that relate directly to your course - your research could take you anywhere...*



### RESOURCE LISTS

Explore lists of resources created by academic tutors, containing recommended material for you to read, listen to and watch.

### TEXT TO SPEECH
